

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR  
THE EMERGING TECHNOLOGIES PRE-VENTURE FUND BOARD**

Public Notice is hereby given in accordance with Title 29, 10004 of the *Del. C.*, as amended, and 76 Del. Laws, c. 79§46(d) (7/1/2007), that the Emerging Technologies Pre-Venture Fund Board (the “Board”) under The Delaware Economic Development Authority (the “Authority”) will conduct a public meeting on Wednesday, October 28<sup>th</sup> 2009 at 8.30 am in the Conference Room at Buena Vista, 661 South DuPont Highway in New Castle, Delaware 19720, with respect to the applications for assistance for the provision of financial support by the Authority in connection with the proposed financing of the projects, in the amounts and on behalf of the applicants identified below. The public is invited to attend and participate in the meeting. In advance of the meeting, additional information concerning the application to be considered at the meeting may be obtained from, and written comments may be submitted to, the Board in care of the Authority, 99 Kings Highway, Dover, Delaware 19901, (302) 739-4271. The Board intends to conduct a part of the meeting in one or more executive sessions closed to the public for the purpose of discussing certain confidential commercial and financial information submitted by the applicants for assistance that is not a public record within the meaning of Section 10002 of the *Del.C.* The agenda for the meeting, which is subject to change, is as follows:

1. **DelaWind, LLC:** The Applicant is requesting \$350,000 from the Emerging Technologies Pre-Venture Fund. The Applicant proposes to use the proceeds to continue core operations, to raise additional funding and securing Federal loan guarantees, to start sales and marketing efforts in the onshore and offshore markets, to complete wind tower design and engineering and to prepare for facilities expansion to accommodate tower fabrications.

2. **AccelBeam Synthesis, Inc.:** The Applicant is requesting \$500,000 from the Emerging Technologies Pre-Venture Fund. The Applicant proposes to use the proceeds to achieve the milestone of manufacturing and selling their initial ten units, to complete flow-through reactor product development and to cover delay in receivables for this Delaware start-up company.

3. **Elcritron:** The Applicant is requesting \$50,000 from the Emerging Technologies Pre-Venture Fund. The Applicant proposes to use the proceeds in the continuing development of “platform” bacteria strains that are suitable for industrial scale fuel-alcohol production from sustainable and environmentally friendly feedstocks (bio-based fuels).
